The Polytechnic University of Bucharest participated on January 30-31, in Cyprus, in the second meeting of the DIGI4ME project - Health sector skill alliance for creating innovative and efficient VET programmes and improving the digital Skills of medical physics and health professionals DIGI4ME.

In addition to project management aspects (the status of activities up to now), at the meeting aspects related to the completion of IT courses dedicated to medical specialists were discussed. The courses will have both written and video support and will be accessible in the languages of all the countries participating in the project (English, Romanian, Greek and German). In addition, they will be accredited in the European Union.

All those interested will be able to register for free and participate online or physically in the health congresses organized in the four countries (Romania, Greece, Cyprus and Germany) in the training courses.

The educational platform that will host the online courses was created as part of the project by specialists from the Computer Faculty at the University of Cyprus and will be fully functional by March 2023.

The courses will be tested and evaluated by a sample of at least 25 participants from each country, the final goal being a correct assessment of the understanding of the educational materials and their improvement according to the needs of each category of participants.

Both the courses and the educational platform will be promoted at events in the medical field (congresses) between May and September 2023, during which digital seminars dedicated to the results of the DIGI4ME project will be organized.

The main aim of the DIGI4ME project is to address the skills gap in the healthcare workforce and provide an innovative training framework together with a certification scheme. The project will address the first 4 CEC levels. It will formulate a wide range of courses to improve the skills of health professionals.
